A Study in Success

Four University of Newcastle researchers are among the first in Australia to receive prestigious Future Fellowships, recognising their world-class studies at the University.

Federal Member for Newcastle, Sharon Grierson MP, yesterday congratulated the recipients of the Fellowship, which aims to address the gap in opportunities for mid-career researchers in Australia.

"Many of our best and brightest researchers are lured overseas to undertake their studies, and the Future Fellowships scheme aims to stop this migration," Ms Grierson said.

"Having four fellowships awarded to Newcastle University is a credit to the breadth and depth of research undertaken there."

Funded over four years, the total worth of the four Fellowships is \$2,366,400.

The Fellows and their research projects are:

Dr V. Haskins – *In Her Place: State intervention and Indigenous domestic service in Australia and the United States*

Prof S.O. Moheimani – *Advanced model-based control for ultra-fast and ultra-high precision nanoscale position*

Prof M.J. Ostwald – *Complex and nonlinear pattern analysis in architectural space, form and program: developing computation tools to support social and cultural design*

Dr M.W. Parsons – *Prediction of tissue fate and functional outcome in acute ischemic stroke with advanced imaging analysis: experimental validation and translational studies*

"I congratulate the successful fellows and wish them all the best in their studies," Ms Grierson said.
