YOUR RIGHTS AT WORK PUBLIC FORUM

Federal Member for Newcastle Sharon Grierson says a public forum tonight will examine the impact of the Howard Government's industrial relations changes on working people in our region.

"In the lead up to the State Election, the danger of allowing Peter Debnam's Liberals to hand NSW's industrial relations system to John Howard should also be noted," Ms Grierson said.

"There are two ways that people can protect their rights at work this year."

"First, to return the Lemma Government at the State Election on 24 March, and second to elect a Rudd Labor Government at the Federal Election later this year."

"A vote for the ALP at the State Election is a vote to keep John Howard's hands off those workers currently protected under NSW law."

"A vote for the ALP at the Federal Election is a vote to get rid of John Howard's extreme industrial relations laws and restore fairness in the workplace."

"I urge all people who are concerned about their rights at work to do both."
